## PROJECT SUPPLIES (Available for purchase at AVS):

Metro Rings Kit (Includes fabric for the quilt top, pattern and quick curve ruler)
OR

- Pattern: "Metro Rings" by Sew Kind of Wonderful
- One Jelly Roll of fabric OR 1/3 yard of ten different prints (cut into 2 ½" strips)
- 5 yards of background fabric
- 1/2 yard each of two fabrics for setting triangles (see pattern for explanation)
- Quick Curve Ruler (this is required for this project)
- Optional: Curved sewing presser foot

## **MACHINE SUPPLIES:**

- A SEWING MACHINE IN GOOD WORKING ORDER
- Foot Pedal and power cord
- Presser feet that came with your machine
- Extra bobbins and 80/12 or 90/14 needles
- Manual

## OTHER SUPPLIES (Available for purchase at AVS):

- Thread to match fabric.
- Clover straight pins or Clover wonder clips.
- Frixion/fabric marking pen. (Light-colored fabric marker if using dark print fabrics)
- Scissors.
- Seam ripper.
- Iron and ironing mat.
- 45mm Rotary cutter or smaller (60mm will not work)
- Extra rotary cutter blades (a VERY sharp blade is extremely important for successful use of curved ruler)
- Rotary cutting mat.
- 10" or larger square ruler (for squaring up blocks)
- Stiletto or "Purple Thang"

## **CLASS PRE-WORK:**

- If you are using yardage, cut the width of the fabric into 2½" strips. You need four strips of each print.
- For both Jelly Roll and yardage, cut each strip in half cross wise. You should now have strips that are 2½" by approximately 21".
- BACKGROUND fabric: Pre-cut the background fabric into triangles and rectangles according to step #1 and #2 of the cutting instructions for background fabric on page 1 of the pattern. A dozen or so of each of these pieces is enough for the class. (Setting Triangles do not need to be cut yet.)
